6 SEC. 2. JURISDICTION OVER FIXED SITE AMUSEMENT 7 RIDES.

8 Section 3(a)(1) of the Consumer Product Safety Act
9 (15 U.S.C. 2052(a)(1)) is amended by striking ", and
10 which is not permanently fixed to a site. Such term does

not include such a device which is permanently fixed to
 a site." and inserting a period.

3 SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

4 There are authorized to be appropriated to the Con5 sumer Product Safety Commission \$500,000 for each fis6 cal year to enable the Commission to carry out the Con7 sumer Product Safety Act as amended by this Act.
